GENERAL RULES

- ❖ **TWO TEAMS** of the 10 participating Provincial Teams will advance to **Nationals** to be held in **Charlottetown PEI** on April 27-28 2018
- ❖ **The entry fee \$50.00.** Re-Entry Fee is **\$50.00 cash** only (First Come/1st Serve). Cheques can be made payable to **CALGARY 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION** and cannot be postdated. NSF cheques will nullify entry. Bowling credits will be honored. **Entries will be accepted at Bowl Alberta member centres within Calgary and Area only. OFFICIAL ENTRY DEADLINE: by CLOSING TIME OF BOWLING CENTRE, SUNDAY November 26, 2017.**
- ❖ All bowlers must be current members of the A5PBA and must be 19 years old as of December 31 of the current bowling season. An A5PBA membership card can be purchased at the event if necessary.
- ❖ Entrants must use their highest current league average as of November 19, 2017 of the current bowling season based on a minimum of fifteen (15) games bowled in league. Bowlers must provide verification of their average with their entry.
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee. There will be a maximum of four (4) bowlers per lane per shift, unless the numbers of entries necessitate a change.
- ❖ The tournament will consist of two five (5) game shifts on Sunday, December 3 2017, at Millennium Lanes.
- ❖ The top four qualifiers of men and women based on pins over average (POA) will represent the Calgary Zone at Provincials. First and second place on both sides shall make up Team 1 and third and fourth on both sides shall make up Team 2.
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the course of the tournament will be addressed and decided on at the tournament committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Personalized balls must be engraved with identifying letters or symbols and may be randomly inspected. Participating bowling centers are not responsible for damaged balls.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e. iPods, mp3 players, cell phones, etc.) will not be permitted on the lanes.
- ❖ Dress code will be neat and tidy and at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- ❖ The POA Provincials will be January 6-7, 2018 in St. Albert, Alberta

Coaches may submit their application for consideration up until the Calgary Zone POA teams are declared but teams may solicit coaches outside those names submitted within the Calgary Zone. All coaches, including those solicited by the zone teams, **must complete the POA Coach Application Form** available online at www.calgary5pin.ca, the POA Chairperson or Bowl Alberta member centres in the Calgary Zone and must submit their applications with all required documentation to a Bowl Alberta member bowling centre within the Calgary area, ATTN: POA Chairperson.
