# CALGARY ZONE OPEN TRIALS

## GENERAL RULES

- ❖ **The Entry Fee is \$160.00.** Entry Fees received after the official cutoff date and thirty minutes prior to the lane draw is \$190.00 cash and must be delivered to the lane draw location. Cheques can be made payable to the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association and cannot be postdated. NSF cheques will nullify entry. Bowling credits will be honored. **Entries will be accepted at Bowl Alberta member centers in Calgary or Airdrie only or by the Cal5PBA open chairperson(s)**  
**OFFICIAL ENTRY DEADLINE: 9:00 PM, SATURDAY, JANUARY 20, 2018.**
- ❖ All bowlers must be current members of the Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers Association and must be 19 years old as at December 31 of the current bowling season.
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee. There will be a maximum of four (4) bowlers per lane per shift, unless the number of entries necessitates a change.
- ❖ The tournament will consist of two (2) ten (10) game shifts (4:00 PM Saturday January 27 at PARADISE LANES and 10:00 AM, Sunday January 28 at TOPPLER BOWL.)
- ❖ The top six (6) men and top six (6) ladies based on total pinfall shall make up the Calgary Men's and Ladies' teams. The next three (3) men and three (3) ladies based on total pinfall shall make up the Calgary Mixed team.
- ❖ In the case of a tie for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, or alternate positions a one game roll-off will be bowled.
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the course of the tournament will be addressed and decided on at the tournament committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Personalized balls must be engraved with identifying letters or symbols and may be randomly inspected. Participating bowling centers are not responsible for damaged balls.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e. iPods, mp3 players, cell phones, etc...) will not be permitted on the lanes.
- ❖ The dress code will be neat and tidy and at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- ❖ The Provincial Championships will be held in Medicine Hat March 28-31.
- ❖ The National Championships will be held in Gatineau, Quebec May 30- June 2.
