## CALGARY ZONE OPEN TRIALS GENERAL RULES

- ❖ **All current applicable government requirements for the operation of the centre and this event will be followed.**
- ❖ **The entry fee \$200.00 (payable at the event).** Cash preferred/Cheques accepted. Cheques can be made payable to **CALGARY 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION** and cannot be postdated. NSF cheques will nullify entry. Bowling credits will be honored. **Online entries will be accepted up to the entry deadline of 7:00 PM Jan 26, 2022.**
- ❖ All bowlers must be current members of the A5PBA and must be 19 years old as of December 31, 2021.
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee. There will be a maximum of four (4) bowlers per lane per shift, unless the numbers of entries necessitate a change.
- ❖ The tournament will consist of two (2) ten (10) game shifts (2:00 PM on Saturday January 29<sup>th</sup>, at **Paradise Lanes** and 10:00 AM Sunday January 30<sup>th</sup> at **Toppler Bowl**).
- ❖ Any bowler who fails to complete the Zone round, without approval to withdraw granted by the Tournament Committee, shall be subject to review by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board and could be issued a suspension from competing in future Calgary Zone events.
- ❖ The top six (6) men and top six (6) ladies based on total pinfall shall make up the Calgary Mens and Ladies teams. The next three (3) men and next three (3) ladies based on total pinfall shall make up the Calgary Mixed team.
- ❖ In case of a tie for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> or alternate positions; a one game roll-off will be bowled.
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the tournament will be addressed and decided on at the tournament committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Personalized balls must be engraved with identifying letters or symbols and may be randomly inspected. Participating bowling centers are not responsible for damaged balls.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e., iPods, mp3 players, cell phones, etc.) will not be permitted on the lanes.
- ❖ Dress code will be neat and tidy and at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

### **COVID-19 Considerations:**

The Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association always prioritizes the safety of our bowlers and the staff members of our bowling centres, and we are committed to working with our proprietors to ensure that our events can go forward in a safe, sustainable way.

**All current applicable AHS & City of Calgary requirements for the operation of the centre and this zone round will be followed.**

We will be collecting and storing some personal information, which is not to be distributed unless an incident occurs. Failure to comply with the government regulations will result in your removal from the event.

Please *do not* attend one of our events if you are feeling ill. If you withdraw before the start of play, your full entry fee will be refunded. Should you develop symptoms consistent with those associated with COVID-19 during the course of the event, you are expected to inform the tournament committee and withdraw immediately. A partial refund will be considered by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board of Directors and no further repercussions will occur. COVID-19 symptoms excluded, any bowler who starts, but fails to complete the event without approval to withdraw from the tournament committee, shall be subject to review by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board and could be issued a suspension from competing in future events.

**Each successful Provincial winner will be assessed \$400.00 by the Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers Association.**
