CALGARY INTER PROVINCIAL ZONE GENERAL RULES

- ❖ **TWO TEAMS** of the participating Provincial Teams will advance to Nationals to be held in **Thunder Bay, Ontario** on April 27-29, 2023
- ❖ **All current applicable government requirements for the operation of the centre and this event will be followed.**
- ❖ **The entry fee \$60.00.** Re-Entry Fee is **\$60.00** (First Come/1st Serve). Cheques can be made payable to **CALGARY 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION** and cannot be postdated. NSF cheques will nullify entry. Bowling credits will be honored.
- ❖ **Entries for the first shift will be accepted on the Calgary 5 website up to the entry deadline of midnight, Saturday November 26, 2022. Late entries (after deadline) will be scheduled in the second shift only as space permits on December 3, 2022.**
- ❖ All bowlers must be current members of the A5PBA and must be 19 years of age or older as of December 31 of the current bowling season. An A5PBA membership card can be purchased at the event if necessary.
- ❖ Entrants must use their highest average (**league or spare**) (**whichever is highest**) based on a minimum of fifteen (15) games as of November 12, 2022, of the current bowling league season. Bowlers must provide verification of their average with their entry.
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Event Committee. There will be a maximum of four (4) bowlers per lane per shift, unless the numbers of entries necessitate a change.
- ❖ Event will consist of two five (5) game shifts on Saturday, December 3, 2022, at Paradise Lanes.
- ❖ The top four qualifiers of men and women based on pins over average (POA) will represent the Calgary Zone at Provincials. First and second place on both sides shall make up Team 1 and third and fourth on both sides shall make up Team 2.
- ❖ **Each team member will need to pay for their first shirt (Cost less 50\$ covered by Calgary 5). Full cost for additional shirts.**
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the event will be addressed and decided on at the event committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Personalized balls must be engraved with identifying letters or symbols and may be randomly inspected. Participating bowling centers are not responsible for damaged balls.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e., iPods, mp3 players, cell phones, etc.) will not be permitted on the lanes.
- ❖ Dress code will be neat and tidy and at the discretion of the Event Committee.

All current applicable AHS & City of Calgary requirements for the operation of the centre and this zone round will be followed.

We will be collecting and storing some personal information, which is not to be distributed unless an incident occurs. Failure to comply with the government regulations will result in your removal from the event.

Please *do not* attend one of our events if you are feeling ill. If you withdraw before the start of play, your full entry fee will be refunded. Should you develop flu or COVID symptoms during the event, you are expected to inform the tournament committee and withdraw immediately. A partial refund will be considered by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board of Directors and no further repercussions will occur. Any bowler who starts but fails to complete the event without approval to withdraw from the tournament committee, shall be subject to review by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board and could be issued a suspension from competing in future events.

**Each successful Provincial winner will be assessed \$325.00 by the Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers Association.
Assessment payment is due one week prior to National event.**
