CALGARY YOUTH CHALLENGE ZONE GENERAL RULES

- ❖ All bowlers must hold a current A5PBA membership in good standing to be eligible to compete.
- ❖ Entry Fee is \$50.00 to be paid Saturday Nov 26 before the start of the event.
- ❖ Entries will be accepted online within the Calgary zone; entry deadline is November 19, 2022 at 9:00pm
- ❖ **Open to all bowlers twelve (12) years of age and older and not yet nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2022.**
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee. The tournament will consist of two (2), four (4) game blocks: 2:00PM November 26 at Paradise Lanes and 9:00am, November 27 at Toppler Bowl
- ❖ The two contingents will be decided as follows:
The top five (5) boys and five (5) girls based on total pinfall shall make up the first Boys' and Girls' Teams. The next two (2) boys and two (2) girls, with the 15th qualifying spot on the contingent being awarded to either the next boy or girl who has the higher pinfall, shall make up the first Mixed Team. The next five (5) boys and five (5) girls based on total pinfall shall make up the second Boys' and Girls' Teams. The next two (2) boys and two (2) girls, with the 30th qualifying spot being awarded to either the next boy or girl who has the higher pinfall, shall make up the second Mixed Team.
- ❖ In the event of a tie for any position which impacts the placement on a team, or for first place, a one (1) game roll-off will be bowled.
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the course of the tournament will be addressed and decided on at the tournament committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ Any bowler who fails to complete the Zone round, without approval to withdraw granted by the tournament committee, shall be subject to review by the Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Board and could be issued a suspension from competing in future Calgary Zone events.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Personal bowling balls must be engraved with identifying markings and may be randomly inspected by tournament officials. Host bowling centres are not responsible for damaged balls.
- ❖ Lane Courtesy MUST Be used and will be enforced by the judges of play.
- ❖ Dress code will be neat and tidy at the discretion of the tournament committee. Shirts must have sleeves and no hats will be allowed. No Pajama pants, no rips or tears.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, headphones, music players etc...) will not be permitted in the bowler's enclosure or on the lanes.
- ❖ This is a non-smoking event. The consumption of alcohol or narcotics is prohibited. Bowlers found under the influence of such substances will be disqualified and suspended from A5PBA events immediately.
- ❖ The Provincial Championships will be held in Edmonton, AB Feb 3-4, 2023
- ❖ The National Championships will be held in Winnipeg, MB March 22-26, 2023
